

## Degrees in the UK

Educational institutions: Universities and Colleges.

Colleges primarily concentrate on vocational training (Further Education), and it is in these institutions that HND courses are typically offered.

Before starting your studies at a UK university.

#### Bachelor's Degree (BA Hons/BSc) -

This university-level qualification typically spans 3 years, except for Medicine or Dentistry students, who require 6 years to finish their studies.

Top-Up Course - By adding an extra year with a Top-Up Course to your HND (Higher National Diploma), you can elevate your qualification to a full university degree. Thus, two years of an HND Course plus one year of Top-Up Course equals a Bachelor's degree equivalent.

Universities are primarily focused on academic studies (Higher Education), offering programs such as Top-Up Courses, Bachelor's Degrees, and Master's Degrees.

Master's Degree (MA/MSc) - After finishing your undergraduate studies, you can pursue further education with a postgraduate or master's degree. This advanced degree typically requires 1 to 2 years to complete.

HND Course - An HND (Higher National Diploma) Course involves two years of study in a specialised higher education program tailored to the practical demands of various sectors. You have the option to extend this qualification with a Top-Up Course. Completing just the two-year HND Course awards you a Higher National Diploma, a formal UK credential that is recognised internationally.

## Student Loans

Student Loans are a type of financial aid provided by the UK Government to enable individuals from diverse economic backgrounds to attend university.

Individuals who fulfil certain criteria can apply for this advantageous financing option. The UK government's aim isn't to profit from students but to integrate as many skilled individuals as possible into the workforce

Put simply, this is financial support from the Government to cover the costs of higher education, including both undergraduate and postgraduate studies, and also to assist with students' living expenses during their time in education.

You should know that there are two types of student loans:

#### **Tuition Fee Loan**

This setup handles tuition fees by directly sending the payments to the university or college, freeing students from the responsibility of making these payments on their own.

#### **Maintenance Fee Loan**

A loan provided to help with living expenses, paid straight to the student.

# Eligibility requirements for Student Loans

For eligibility for a UK Government Student Loan, you must satisfy the following conditions:

You need to have been a resident in the UK since before January 2021. Nonetheless, there are exceptions where individuals from outside the EU might qualify for these loans, and our team can provide more detailed guidance on this.

You need to possess at least an intermediate proficiency in English.

You must hold Settled status, Pre-settled status, an indefinite residence permit, or any other visa type that permits you to apply for government funding.

Applicants holding Pre-Settled status are required to submit evidence of employment or financial backing from a family member (spouse or parents for those under 25).

Applicants possessing Settled status are not required to furnish employment proof.

## Repayment for Student Loans

The repayment conditions for Student Loans in the UK typically include the following elements:

Student Loans in the UK are designed to be repaid only when the borrower is financially able to do so, functioning more like a tax than a conventional loan. Repayment begins the April after course completion, but only if the borrower's annual earnings surpass the threshold set by Student Finance England.

 As of the 2024 update, repayment calculations are based on a percentage of income exceeding this threshold, ensuring that repayments are income-contingent.

## The repayment thresholds for various plans have been updated.


For example, Plan 1 has a yearly threshold of £22,015, and Plan 2's threshold is £27,295. The repayment is typically set at 9% of the income over the threshold for Plans 1, 2, 4, and 5, and 6% for Postgraduate Loans. Changes in annual income will affect the repayment amount, with the possibility of stopping payments if employment is lost until the income threshold is exceeded again.

Furthermore, the interest rates for Plan 2, Plan 5, and Postgraduate Loans have been capped at 7.6% as of January 2024, despite the RPI rate being much higher. This cap is reviewed monthly and is intended to keep student loan interest rates in line with or below prevailing market rates for comparable unsecured personal loans.

The system is designed so higher earners from university education pay more, with loan cancellations after 30 years or in certain conditions like low income, promoting fairness [86†source] [87†source] [88†source].




